MSN Completion Program

The MSN Completion program is designed for nationally Certified Nurse Practitioners, Nurse Midwives and Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists who wish to obtain a Master of Science in Nursing degree. The program is offered on the Newark and Stratford campuses.

Role and Scope of Practice: Graduates of the UMDNJ-SN Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) Program are prepared to provide specialized comprehensive nursing care through independent and collaborative practice with other health professionals as advanced practice nurses in a variety of health care settings.

Admission Requirements:

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing
- Graduation from a certified practitioner program which requires a BSN for admission
- Current licensure as a registered professional nurse (RN)
- Current **American Heart Association** Basic Life Support (BLS) certification in Adult, Child, Infant and AED.
- National Certification as a Nurse Practitioner, Nurse Midwife or Nurse Anesthetist
- State Certification as a Nurse Practitioner, Nurse Midwife or Nurse Anesthetist (if applicable)
- One year current experience as a Nurse Practitioner, Nurse Midwife or Nurse Anesthetist
- Graduation residency requirement of thirteen (13) credits
- **Note:** the requirements for Basic Health Assessment and TOEFL are waived for this program only
