



## Clinical Leadership MSN Program

The Clinical Leadership MSN Program is based at UMDNJ's Newark campus.

**Role and Qualifications:** Graduates of this program will be prepared at the generalist level to assume clinical nurse leader roles at the point of care. The Clinical Nurse Leader oversees the care coordination of a distinct group of patients and actively provides direct patient care in complex situations. The CNL evaluates patient outcomes, assesses cohort risk and has the decision-making authority to change care when necessary. The CNL is a leader in the health care delivery system, and the implementation of this role will vary across settings.

**Curriculum:** The 33-credit Clinical Leadership MSN program can be completed through part-time study. Students attend classes in a prescribed sequence. The following are the required courses and the sequence for this program.
