



Post Master's Certification Program in Nurse Midwifery

The Post-Masters Certificate Program will be offered at the UMDNJ School of Nursing on the Newark and Stratford campuses. The program is designed for Registered Nurses who already hold a Master of Science in Nursing degree and wish to pursue another specialty area.

The Post Master's Certificate Program in Nurse Midwifery is designed for registered nurses who:

Option I: Hold a Master of Science degree in Nursing, but are not certified Advanced Practice.

Thirteen (13) credit hours in Nursing Research, Advanced Pathophysiology, Advanced Pharmacology, and Advanced Health Assessment are required. The total number of credits will be variable if any or all of the above courses are taken at UMDNJ.

Option II: Hold a Master of Science degree in Nursing and are nationally certified women's health nurse practitioners.

Option III: Hold a Master of Science degree in Nursing and are nationally certified nurse practitioners.

*WHNM 5207 & WHNM 5307 must be taken in order to be in compliance with the ACNM Division of Accreditation. The candidate may also have to take NURS 5106 & NURS 5401 if this content was not part of their prior education program.

**Family Health Nurse Practitioners do not have to take WHNM 5107 Primary Care of Women.
